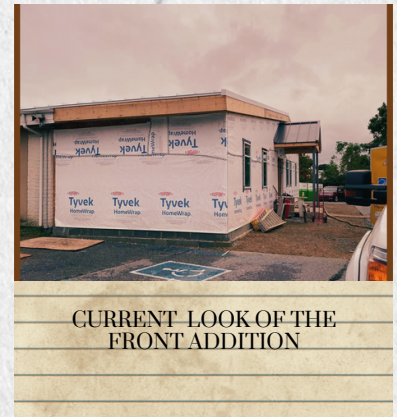

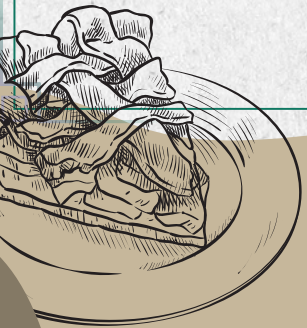
Want a chance to win some cool prizes while helping out your library at the same time? Then enter into our annual raffle drawing.

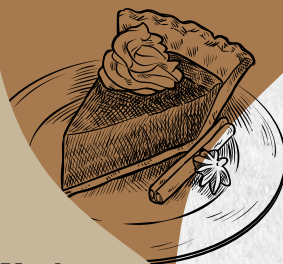
### APPLE DUMPLINGS, ANYONE?
