Objective: Maintain our Gold Star Status in the PA Forward Initiative by actively look for ways we can be a community center for information, technology, and learning.

Goal III: Strengthen our community; providing and connecting patrons to quality programs and services.

Objective: Assess programming for all age groups, looking for ways to better serve our populations. Investigate the possibilities of community-driven programming and volunteer opportunities.

Goal IV: Sustainability
