Shoot for the Moon, Snoopy! Selected as Next Title for Berks Libraries/Reading Public Museum StoryWalk®

For immediate release—Starting February 27, visitors to the Reading Public Museum’s Arboretum will be able to explore a new book on the StoryWalk® trail: *Shoot for the Moon, Snoopy!* inspired by Charles Schulz, written by Jason Cooper, and illustrated by Vicki Scott.

The Arboretum StoryWalk® is a collaboration between Berks County Public Libraries and the Reading Public Museum to bring together the joys of reading and love of the outdoors. Featured titles are bilingual stories that are periodically rotated to align with current Museum exhibitions.

In *Shoot for the Moon, Snoopy!* lovable dog Snoopy prepares to go to the moon. He quickly realizes, though, that training for space is hard work...especially when Peppermint Patty and Marcie decide to become his personal coaches.

This special storybook is based on the Peanuts partnership with NASA which is further explored in the Museum’s exhibition [*To the Moon: Snoopy Soars with NASA, curated by the Charles M. Schulz Museum and Research Center, Santa Rosa, California, U.S.A.*](#)
