Mission:

The Kutztown Community Library informs, enriches, and empowers our community by providing access to information, technology, services, and programming.

Vision:

As the community hub, the Kutztown Community Library provides a diverse resource center in a welcoming environment.

About Us:

The Kutztown Community Library (KCL) was founded in 1949 and is a non-profit 501(c)3 corporation. The KCL provides service to the rural community of Kutztown Borough, Lyons Borough, Maxatawny Township and Greenwich Township (17,121 residents based on the 2010 U.S. Census). Albany Township (1,724 residents) joined in 2018 for a total library service population of 18,845. Lenhartsville Borough (165 residents) is not currently included. There are nine Trustees on the Board that represent our service area.

In 2017:

- KCL's collection consisted of 30,000 books, audio books, and DVDs
- The items circulated nearly 100,000 times
- 5,000 electronic materials were used.
- There were over 72,000 visits to the library
- Our free WiFi and computers were used for 11,000 one-hour sessions
- KCL hosted over 700 programs with 12,000 attendees for all age levels
- 1,600 passport applications were processed
- The library was open 52.5 hours per week
- Staff worked approximately 190 hours per week

Goals and Objectives:

Collections, Programs, Technology, & Services

- 9. To expand multi-media materials
- 10. To celebrate 70th anniversary in 2019
- 11. To develop programs and resources to engage the post-college age group
- 12. To develop programs and resources to engage the 65-100 year-old age group

Management & Finances

Goal 2: KCL should have a system of stable funding resources and management to meet the needs of the community.

- 1. To develop sustainable funding to meets KCL's goals
- 2. To seek grants to meet library goals
- 3. To establish a credit/debit card for library use
- 4. To expand the donor base to create consistent and reliable contributions
- 5. To establish a fundraising manager and investigate a donor record system
- 6. To establish chairs for Board committees
- 7. To review policies, mission and vision statements
- 8. To evaluate library operating hours and systems
- 9. To investigate the feasibility of establishing an Endowment Fund
- 10. To explore ways to increase community donations to reach 50% of our annual income

- 6. To offer accredited training for teens and adults
- 7. To partner with therapy dog organization
- 8. To partner with Rodale Institute
- 9. To explore incorporating Lenhartsville Borough into our library service area

Public Relations

Goal 4: Community residents and local organizations should be well-informed about Kutztown Community Library's resources, services and facilities.

- 3. To continue creating a mailed newsletter and eNewsletter
