Activity packs will be available each week so you can participate even if you can't attend.

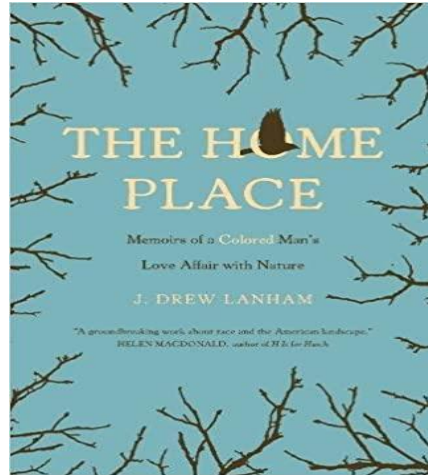
